2026 IYP Camp Programs Registration Important Dates

2026 Winter Camp Program	September 1, 2025	December 15, 2025 or until all available spots are filled, whichever occurs first
2026 Toronto Summer Camp Programs	September 15, 2025	May 15, 2026 or until all available spots are filled, whichever occurs first
2026 Parent & Child Toronto Camp Program	September 15, 2025	May 15, 2026 or until all available spots are filled, whichever occurs first
2026 China TechVenture Camp Programs	September 15, 2025	May 15, 2026 or until all available spots are filled, whichever occurs first
2026 Ottawa Camp Programs	September 15, 2025	May 29, 2026 or until all available spots are filled, whichever occurs first
2026 Canada Adventure Camp Program	September 15, 2025	May 29, 2026 or until all available spots are filled, whichever occurs first

Important Note for Canada Camp Programs Applicants:

1. For international students who require a visa to enter Canada, please allow enough time for visa application processing. Due to limited intake capacity for each program, we may request that applicants facing visa-related delays consider alternate program options.
2. Students who meet any of the following conditions can apply **two weeks before** the program start dates:
 - a. is a Canadian citizen
 - b. have a valid Canadian visitor visa
 - c. have a valid Canadian study permit and reside in Canada
 - d. can enter Canada with an eTA



2026 IYP Camp Programs Registration Process

Registration Process:

Step by Step	Instruction
STEP 1	Complete and sign the registration forms (including consent and waivers) and submit all the required documents to admissions@internationalyouthprogram.com .
STEP 2	Make your payment and provide us with proof of transaction. <ul style="list-style-type: none">Upon receipt of the complete registration package, IYP staff will issue an invoice to the applicant.The paid invoice and official acceptance letter will be issued once the payment is received.
STEP 3	Submit your Canadian visitor visa application (if applicable, for Canada camp programs only). Present the IYP acceptance letter, paid invoice and other supporting documents required by Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC).
STEP 4	Once your visa application is approved, please send us a copy of your Canadian visa counterfoil/sticker page (if applicable, for Canada camp programs only).
STEP 5	Complete and sign your flight information sheet. Please provide us with your arrival AND departure flight information. Ensure the information is current and accurate for airport pick-up/drop-off service.
STEP 6	Prepare for your trip. It's mandatory for Canada camp program students to complete our English placement test. Please complete this test at least ONE week before your program start date. Read our camp student handbook and pre-arrival guide to prepare for your arrival.

Refund and Cancellation Policy

Refund and Cancellation

Registration Fee

A non-refundable registration fee of CAD 200 per person is required at the time of registration. This fee is non-refundable under any circumstances, including visa refusal, cancellation, or deferral.

Visa Refusal

If an applicant is unable to attend the program due to a visa refusal by IRCC (Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada), a full refund of the paid program fee will be issued.

To be eligible for this refund, please provide:

- A copy of the official visa refusal letter from IRCC

Non-Visa Related Cancellations

We understand that sometimes plans change. In the event that an applicant must cancel the program, the applicant must provide a signed cancellation request form. The form must be submitted to our office via email. Cancellations are effective from the date the signed form is received.

Refund Schedule:

- Cancellations 8 or more weeks before the program start date: refund 85% of the paid program fee;
- Cancellations 7-5 weeks before the program start date: 50% of the paid program fee;
- Cancellations 4 or less before the program start date: 0% of the paid program fee.

*To ensure fairness, transparency, and clear expectations, the above refund and cancellation policies apply to all applicants (students, accompanying family members if applicable) for our camp programs.





Insurance

Health Insurance covers all camp students during their camp programs. Students and their accompanying parents will receive the Health Insurance card on their first day of the program. Our staff will securely hold these insurance cards to prevent loss. If needed, students may contact us at any time to retrieve their cards. In case a student (or accompanying parent) feels ill or has a medical emergency, please notify our camp course instructor or Residence Advisor.

We strongly encourage our applicants to contact us as early as possible (at least **two weeks** before the selected program start date) if extra days of stay are needed due to flight availability or travel plan changes.

Please note that we need time to arrange the accommodation and update insurance information as required.

Important Notice:

Applicants who have additional travel plans in Canada following the IYP camp program are required to purchase travel insurance at their own cost. Please contact an insurance company for details.

If needed, we can help with the insurance purchase. However, applicants must provide their actual departure date from Canada and pay the applicable insurance fee.

Pre-Arrival Process

Pre-Arrival Process	
Step 1	Read and sign the Consent/Waiver forms and send the forms to admissions@internationalyouthprogram.com if you didn't do so at the time of application submission.
Step 2	Complete the IYP English placement test at least ONE week before the program start date. The English placement test instructions will be sent approximately FOUR weeks before the program start date. This test is mandatory for Canada camp program students to determine their appropriate English level for course placement.
Step 3	Read our camp student handbook and use it as a reference for your trip preparation. IYP will send the latest student handbook with the English placement test instructions.
Step 4	Read our pre-arrival guide, find our primary contact and address. This information is very important once you arrive.

Arrival

For IYP arranged accommodation/ University Residence applicants	<ul style="list-style-type: none">If airport pick-up service is requested in the provided flight information sheet, our camp staff will wait for the students (and accompanying parents if applicable) at the airport arrival area and send them to the camp residence address.If airport pick-up service is NOT requested in the provided flight information sheet, students (and accompanying parents if applicable) should arrive at the residence address on time. IYP camp staff will confirm the detailed address and time before the students' arrival. We will welcome the students on site and help with their residence check-in. <p>*IMPORTANT* If unaccompanied minor service is arranged with the airline, we will charge an unaccompanied minor service fee of \$200 (\$100 for each way). Please include this information on the flight information sheet.</p>
For Self-arranged accommodation applicants	<p>Our camp staff will confirm the meeting time and location before students' arrivals, and students are expected to show up on time for camp courses and activities.</p> <p>*Although the students are covered by emergency health insurance, their parents/guardians/relatives in Canada should ensure their safety for the daily commute to and from the camp.</p>





Deferral Request

Applicants are allowed to defer their program to:

- A different intake date within the same term, or
- An intake date in the next term.

Example:

An applicant originally applied for the July 6 intake may choose to defer to another summer intake (e.g., August 3) or defer to a winter camp or summer camp in the following year, provided all eligibility conditions are met.

Conditions:

- We offer two program terms per year: summer term and winter term.
- If students (and accompanying parents if applicable) are unable to begin the camp program on time due to pending visa applications or other reasons, please make a deferral request **at least two weeks before** the original program start date.
- Deferral requests must be made in writing and are subject to availability and approval.
- Any price difference resulting from changes in program date, category, or term must be paid by the applicant.
- Each applicant is allowed only one (1) deferral.
- At the time of the new selected intake, the student applicant must be 17 years old or younger, as our programs are designed for youth up to age 17.

Important Note:

- Once a deferral request is submitted and received by IYP, the applicant is no longer eligible for a refund for any **non-Visa-related** reasons.
- The credit for the paid program fee will be retained for up to two (2) years, or until the student applicant's 17th birthday, whichever comes first. After this period, the credit will expire, and the applicant must reapply and pay full fees to join a future program.
