

INTELLIGENT MANUFACTURING TOWN

Hangzhou, Zhejiang, China

The General Aviation Intelligent Manufacturing Town offers a vibrant blend of technology, education, and exploration. At the heart of the town is the General Aviation Science Experience Hall—a 15,000-square-meter interactive space designed to spark curiosity and fuel discovery, where students can pilot through multiscreen simulators, soar in a VR skydiving experience, and dive into a fully immersive 4D motion cinema. Each year, the Hall hosts a variety of youth-focused programs, including STEM workshops, guided educational tours, and weekend science camps that connect aviation principles to real-world applications.

For visiting students, the excitement continues with hands-on access to real aircraft—they can enter hangars, sit inside cockpits, and test basic flight controls under expert guidance, connecting classroon



specializing in augmented reality (AR) and
artificial intelligence (AI). Rokid has
partnered with the Liangzhu Museum to
offer AR-guided tours using their Rokid
Glass. Visitors wear the glasses to see
virtual reconstructions of ancient buildings,
interactive holograms, and real-time
navigation across the site. Rokid also has a
flagship store in Hangzhou's West Lake
District where visitors can explore their

LIANGZHU MUSEUM

Hangzhou, Zhejiang, China

The Liangzhu Museum is a renowned archaeological museum which serves as a vital cultural landmark and a gateway to understanding early Chinese urban society, craftsmanship, and spiritual beliefs. Liangzhu Culture is often cited as evidence of China's 5,000-year civilization. The museum houses over 3,000 artifacts, including jade, pottery, lacquerware, and bone tools. It features three permanent exhibition halls that explore the Water Town and Marshland, the Sacred Land of Civilization, and the Jade Soul and National Spirit. The museum also features VR exhibitions and digital displays to enhance visitor engagement.
