China TechVenture Camp Program Workshops

This innovative and immersive program is designed to ignite young minds through direct engagement with cutting-edge science, technology, and global enterprise. Participants will explore the dynamic world of artificial intelligence, robotics and e-commerce through interactive experiences and behind-the-scenes access to leading institutions and companies.

At Zhejiang University (Zijingang Campus), students explore the fundamentals of robotic engineering through hands-on sessions with robotic arms and cutting-edge robotic systems. Visits to Hangzhou's "Six Little Dragons" offer direct exposure to leading AI and robotics companies, featuring interactive activities such as robot control, drone assembly, and obstacle courses. At iFLYTEK's Hangzhou, students dive into the frontier of AI technology—learning about the history and current landscape of artificial intelligence, and transforming theoretical knowledge into personalized smart products. At Alibaba's global headquarters, students explore e-commerce, international trade, and digital innovation through guided tours and expert-led sessions.

The program cultivates creativity, technical skills, and a global outlook—preparing students for the possibilities of the intelligent era.

Workshop/Course	Introduction
Miracle of China's Chips	Offers students an introduction to the rapid development of China's semiconductor industry. Through expert-led sessions, participants will learn about chip design, key applications in everyday life, and the technological breakthroughs that have contributed to the "miracle of China's chips." This course provides valuable insights into one of the world's most influential high-tech sectors.
Meet the Robots	Participants will study the fundamentals of robotic engineering through hands-on sessions with robotic arms and cutting-edge robotic systems. The workshop features interactive learning with the advanced robotic dog "Jueying," developed by DeepRobotics. This course offers a unique opportunity to experience the forefront of China's robotics innovation in an academic setting.
Immersive Robotics & AI Experience	Explore Hangzhou's "Six Little Dragons"—leading tech companies in AI and robotics. They'll visit city showrooms, interact with robots like G1, and experience hands-on controls, handshakes, and hugs. The program includes a foundational AI course, covering robot structure, control principles, advanced technologies, and future trends to unlock the potential of the intelligent era.
iFLYTEK AI Innovation Classroom	Participants will learn about the cutting-edge developments in AI technology, gain insight into the history and evolution of artificial intelligence, and examine current trends and industry applications. Bridging theory and practice, the program guides students in transforming AI concepts into personalized, innovative products, offering a hands-on experience in the future of intelligent innovation.
Drone Assembly & Obstacle Course Challenge	Through instructor-led sessions, students will learn the basics of drone design, assembly, test flights, and flight competitions. The course introduces drone principles, real-life applications, and a hands-on experience building a quadcopter, making complex concepts easy and fun to grasp.
Alibaba Camp: E-Commerce & Global Trade	Students will visit Alibaba's global headquarters and analyze its growth through interactive displays. They'll learn about Alibaba Day, ESG principles, corporate culture, and the stories behind its century vision and iconic mascots—gaining insights into the world's top e-commerce platform.
Alibaba Bootcamp: Project & Innovation Training	Led by Alibaba staff, this training covers cultural management, financial literacy, digital marketing, internet tech, and new media. Students will explore Alibaba's core values and talent standards to spark creativity and entrepreneurial thinking.

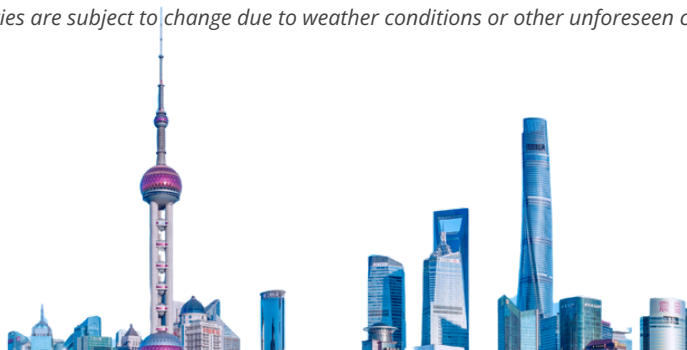
Students have activities every day in the afternoon and during the evening.

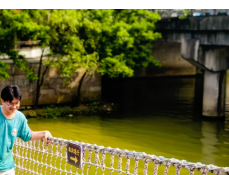
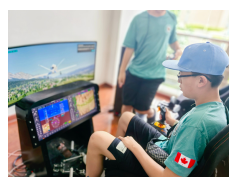
