IYP General English Courses

In today's globalizing society, it is crucial to learn foreign languages and develop an understanding of diversity, logical thinking, and presentation skills.

International Youth Program enables youth to acquire these skills and build awareness through integration and exposure to different cultures. Youth from around the world come together to learn, explore and create memories.

Our program focuses on experiential learning that creates global citizens. International Youth Program offers the perfect combination of communicative language learning and a variety of project-based learning activities.

- **Grammar:** Follows a communicative approach to help students learn the rules and functions of grammar. Students also bridge the gap between understanding English grammar theory and applying grammar correctly in speaking and writing.
- **Communication:** Project-based class designed to teach students the characteristics of native-speaker communication through completing group projects. This enables them to communicate in a fluent and natural way. The class also teaches students functional language and expressions that will enable them to converse clearly in a variety of everyday situations.

IYP General English Course Levels		
Level	Introduction	
Beginner Level (Score: 0 - 40)	Students in this range are developing foundational English skills, including basic vocabulary, grammar, and everyday communication. Instruction at this level focuses on building confidence in speaking, listening, reading, and writing.	
Intermediate Level (Score: 40 - 75)	These students can understand and communicate in most everyday situations. Instruction is designed to expand their vocabulary, improve sentence structure, and strengthen their ability to express ideas more clearly in both spoken and written English.	
Advanced Level (Score: 75 - 100)	Students in this group demonstrate a strong grasp of English and are capable of handling more complex language tasks. The focus is on refining fluency, accuracy, and comprehension in academic and real-world contexts.
