

2026 PHARMACY SUMMER CAMP PROGRAM



Join us this summer to discover the dynamic field of pharmaceutical sciences at one of Canada's premier pharmacy schools!

IYP invites high school students in grades 9–12 to explore key areas in healthcare, with a focus on pharmacology and physiology. Hosted at the Leslie Dan Faculty of Pharmacy at the University of Toronto, the program provides hands-on learning with industry experts. Students will dive into essential topics such as how drugs interact with the body's systems, the basic anatomy and physiology of the human body, and the impact of drug interactions and allergies. Through interactive lectures, group presentations, physical assessments, and case-based problem-solving activities, participants will gain a deeper understanding of both medicine and the human body.

Beyond the academic experience, the camp also offers students the chance to strengthen their academic English through a general English program focused on communication skills and grammar. Alongside these courses, students will enjoy a variety of fun and interactive activities in Toronto—a fantastic opportunity to make new friends, immerse themselves in Canadian culture, and experience the city's vibrant atmosphere.

Pharmacy Summer Camp Topics

Topic	Introduction
The Human Body/Physiology	Focuses on understanding the basic anatomy and physiology of the human body. Students will learn about the major systems (e.g., cardiovascular, respiratory, and nervous) and how they function together. Activities will include interactive lectures, group presentations, and physical assessments for various conditions that affect the human body.
Pharmacology	Participants will explore the principles of pharmacology, including how drugs work in the body, drug interactions, and drug allergies. This week will feature interactive lectures, mystery detective work to figure out the offending agent/poison, and case studies on drug therapies.

Students have activities every day in the afternoon and during the evening. On the weekends, we will take students on out-of-town excursions to famous city sights in Toronto!




